Session 1: Bidding Balanced Hands

This program is designed to take you from basic No Trump & Balanced Opening bidding to the most effective tools used to ensure your optimum final contract. You will discover the key questions for when, what, why and how to bid and respond with balanced hands, as well as, the associated re-bids to reach the probable makeable contract.

Session 2: Partnership System Agreement -Standard American 2 over 1

This session will focus on opening suit bids at the one, two level or higher. The participants will explore modern bidding methods for both the opener & responder to enable their partnership to effectively describe strength, shape and preferred strain of their respective hands. Some of the modern concepts you will learn are 2 over 1, 1NT Forcing, Inverted Minors, Crisscross, Bergen Raises, 2NT Forcing, 2 Way Help Suit Game Tries & more.

Session 3: Contested "Competitive" Auction

This session deals with a number of issues related to competitive auctions. Participants will develop a working knowledge of what, when & how they should compete in an auction; irrespective of how they are contesting the auction (Opener/Responder or Over-caller/Advancer). The topics covered during the six segments for this session could be classified as "Required Tools to Compete". Specifically, you will explore the wide range of Doubles (TOX, Negative, Support, Responsive, Maximal & Penalty), Overcalls, opponent Cue Bids, Preempts & No Trump Interference.
